Aldo Rampazzi, born on the 4th of October 1947, was raised in Ascona and studied Architecture at Zurich's ETH, a city where he then worked for two years. Back in Ticino, in 1977 he opened his own architecture studio in Ascona. As a representative of the liberal party FDP he was active for more than thirty years within the municipality's politics. From 1996 to 2012 he was the Mayor of Ascona. On the 1st of January 2015 he began his appointment as the President of the Board of Directors of the newly-founded marketing organisation 'Agenzia turistica ticinese' (ATT), which superseded the role of the 'Ente Ticinese per il Turismo' (ETT). In addition to his role within the ATT, Aldo Rampazzi has been entrusted with two further mandates, one within the Isole di Brissago's Board of Directors and the second within the Locarno Film Festival. Among his hobbies: skiing, tennis, athletics, hockey and traveling.
