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HIKE, DISCOVER & TASTE...

Discover the wonderful peaks of this area, from Monte Generoso with its chamois colony to Monte San Giorgio, a site of world importance for Triassic fossils, passing through the Muggio Valley and the medieval archaeological site of Tremona.

Enjoy the spectacular scenic views along the way, the vast expanse of the Lombard plain, Lugano Lake and the alpine range to the north.

Eat in an old watermill built almost 400 years ago and still one of the few working ones in Ticino. You will see it in action grinding red maize to be enjoyed as polenta accompanied by other local products.

Taste the world-renowned Merlot in the wineries that dot the region and stroll through the vineyard and the premises in a guided wine-tasting tour. A great way to top-off the day's hike!

Day 1 - Arrival in Ticino

Arrival in Meride and accommodation in the hotel. Welcome dinner with wine tasting.



Day 2 - Monte Generoso The top of the world

A unbique experience with the little cogwheel train that will take us to the Bellavista stop from where we will begin our ascent on foot to the summit of Monte Generoso.

Once at the top, there is a breathtaking view of the Gulf of Lugano and the Alpine chain: from Monte Rosa to the Matterhorn, from the Jungfrau to the Gotthard massif

The rocky plateau is dominated by the 'Stone Flower': the building recently constructed under the guidance of the famous architect Mario Botta. Architecture and gastronomy come together in this place where we *drink*.

Return on foot to Bellavista or train to Capolago In the afternoon visit of the archaeological park of Tremona









Day 3 - Muggio Valley

Let us discover together the Muggio Valley. The southernmost valley in Switzerland, characterised by peace and quiet, magnificent landscapes in an unspoilt environment. One can describe the Muggio Valley as an open-air museum waiting to be explored. Famous for its chestnut forests, roccoli (bird traps), nevere (considered the refrigerators of our ancestors) and mills.

Visit to the core and, for those who wish, entry to the ethnographic museum.

A lwinery of the valley will make us taste their local wine in a different way...Then we will reach a mill follwey by the demonstration and lunch.

In the afternoon visit to the fossil museum to prepare ourselves for the following day.



Day 4 - Mount San Giorgio

Meet with the UNESCO guide for the ascent to Monte San Giorgio. Located at the foot of the Southern Alps, straddling the Canton of Ticino (Switzerland) and the areas of the Pravello and Orsa mountains in the Province of Varese (Italy). Surrounded by the two southern branches of Lake Ceresio, the mountain reaches its highest altitude at 1097 m in Swiss territory. Monte San Giorgio is one of the most important marine fossil deposits in the world from the Middle Triassic (247-237 million years ago).

Day 4 Extension to Morcote

Extension to Morcote: from the peak of Monte San Giorgio, we hike to the Serpiano cable car and descend to Brusino Arsizio. From here with a boat, we reach Morcote, it is considered by the World Toursim Organization in 2024 one of the best tourism villages in the world.
